

# Volunteer Opportunities

Just a friendly reminder: For every \$25 dollars spent equals 1 service hours, please save your receipts, and attach to Service Hour Log.

Each parent is required to do 10 service hours each, which totals 20 per household or 10 per single family households.

All families are required to do 4 service hours for our Auction (2 hours for single families).

Adopt – a – Class (Does not count towards hours but is very much appreciated)

- Bronze - is a one-time \$150 donation.
- Silver – is a one-time donation of \$300
- Gold – is a one-time donation of \$500
- Platinum – is a donation above \$500

This donation goes straight to the classroom, so that the teachers can buy the little things that are needed during the year.

Amazon Wish List

Each classroom has an Amazon wish list. For every \$25.00 spent is equal to 1 hour of service. The teachers update these throughout the school year. Please make sure that you save your receipt and attach it to your service hour log.

Lending Library (2 hours)

This is a once a month opportunity. You can sign up for a specific month you would like to go to your local library and check out books for the classroom. Please make sure that you see the teacher before you check out book, so that they can give you the list of themes that they will be covering that month.

Volunteer Hours Coordinator (10 Hours must keep spread sheet or sign-up genius for all activities)

This amazing person will keep track of who has volunteered and their contact information, i.e. cell phone numbers for group text. They will also distribute the invitations in the folders and keep track of RSVP numbers. A spreadsheet will be provided.

Classroom Laundry (10 hour)

This is a Monthly service hour opportunity. Sign up for the month that you would like to do the laundry for your child's class. This includes cot sheets, blankets, towels, etc. Laundry can be picked up on Fridays after 3:00 pm and returned to school the following Monday morning. There are some Fridays or Mondays that we are closed, please be mindful of that as you sign up. You may have to take the laundry on a Thursday afternoon.

Classroom Parents

We will need 2 parent per classroom to act as classroom parent. These classroom parents will help coordinate for class parties and programs and assist the teacher as needed in our classes throughout the year. Must complete level 2 Background screening and safe environment training.



#### Home and School Board

We need one parent or one couple that would like to sit on our Home and School Board to represent the ECC to the K-8. This is a year-round commitment; they meet once a month.

#### Parent Advisory Council ECC

One parent or one couple per classroom to represent and meet quarterly with the ECC Director.

#### Auction

We need one parent or one couple that would like to sit on the school Auction committee. This would be a long-standing commitment and would require the sharing of information from the Auction committee to the ECC.

#### Moms & muffins & Dinos with Dad

This is a special event to celebrate and say thank you to our Moms and dads for all they do. Each Classroom will need two Moms and two Dads to help serve refreshments and serve the Moms or Dads.

#### Scholastic Volunteer

This will be a long-standing commitment. The Scholastic Volunteer would manage the school's Scholastic account, monthly orders, and getting the monthly flyers sorted for the classrooms.

#### Campus Beautification Chairperson

We need one parent to oversee our playground beautification projects. We are planning on having two separate dates for beautification, one in the fall and one again in the spring.

#### Campus Beautification Monthly

We need one parent per month to keep our grounds looking fresh and clean. Weeding planters, adding mulch if needed. Putting accent items out to keep the area looking nice.

#### Fundraising Chairperson

This is also a long-standing commitment; we need one parent or family to oversee and help plan and coordinate fundraisers with Mrs. Judi.
